• Chemical Safety

- Manage Hazardous Materials on Campus.
- Chemical Inventory that tracks all chemicals being used in campus labs.
 - EHS Assistant
- Begins with the purchase of a chemical.
- That container is tracked "Cradle to Grave".
- This information is used to ensure:
 - proper training of lab personnel
 - safe teaching and research
 - waste minimization.

















- Currently the database contains ~80,000 containers.
- LSU has ~800 laboratories.
- Unused chemicals become waste.
- LSU disposes of ~150,000 pounds of hazardous waste.
- Cost of \$190,000.





- We need your help!
- Current purchasing system doesn't populate the database.
- We now rely on the lab personnel to load in the chemicals.
- Maintaining an accurate inventory in this way is challenging.
- Regulatory Burden
- Federal and state rules require us to accurately report storage of chemicals on an annual basis.





- What can you do?
 - Remind faculty to load chemicals into the database.
 - EHS can assist if you already have an inventory.
