
















## **Gravitational Waves Detected**

## Louisiana Research, National Impact

U.S. Sen. Bill Cassidy was the honorary host of the Louisiana Research Forum on Feb. 16. He was joined by the directors of NIH, NSF and the FDA Center for Drug Evaluation & Research, along with university representatives from across the state. With LSU campuses accounting for 59 percent of federal R&D in Louisiana, the summit helped shed light on the great research opportunities already happening and the potential for more to happen here.

<u>Three LSU students have been selected</u> as finalists for the prestigious Truman Scholarship, which offers up to a \$30,000 for graduate study. A total of 10 LSU students have received the award since 2003.

<u>LSU Veterinary Medicine</u> researchers are using nanotechnology to develop new chemotherapies that won't destroy healthy cells. The university is also studying individual cancel cells to predict how a person's cancer will respond to treatment, before the treatment is even administered.
